"The Art Nouveau Architecture of Georgia" Nestan Tatarashvili

This lecture by architect Nestan Tatarashvili will be of interest to anyone wishing to learn more about the remarkable buildings, balconies and monuments of Tbilisi. Ms. Tatarashvili will speak about the Art Nouveau architectural heritage of the Georgian cities of Tbilisi, Sokhumi, Gagra, Batumi, Poti, Kutaisi, Kobuleti and Dusheti, introducing us to 19th and early 20th century Georgian urban architecture and discussing the spread of Art Nouveau through Georgia's cities. The functional diversity of these Art Nouveau buildings will be shown through visual examples and explanations of their layouts, facades, and decorations. Ms. Tatarashvili will also present archival materials, including drawings, photos, and samples of buildings that are now damaged or no longer exist.
